

Please make plans to attend the Rally for Equal Protection to end abortion on Saturday February 25th, 11 AM at the SC Statehouse in downtown Columbia. Speakers include: Jeff Durbin (End Abortion Now), Bradley Pierce (Foundation to Abolish Abortion), Rob Harris (SC State Representative), & Matt Brock (Operation Save America). South Carolina has the Constitutional and Biblical duty to restore equal protection rights for all pre-born babies beginning at fertilization. Representative Rob Harris has filed House Bill 3549, The SC Prenatal Equal Protection Act, which ends abortion from fertilization by establishing equal protection for all pre-born babies. We Cannot Love God if We Do Not Love His Word

—by R. C. Sproul

Emil Brunner, the twentieth-century Swiss theologian and one of the fathers of neoorthodox theology, wrote a little book titled Truth as Encounter. His thesis was that when we study the things of God, we are not studying truth in the abstract. We want to understand theology not merely so that we can make an A on a theology exam. We want to understand the doctrine of God so that we can understand God, so that we can meet the living God in His Word and deepen our personal relationship with Him. But we cannot deepen a relationship with someone if we do not know anything about him. So, the propositions of Scripture are not an end in themselves but a means to an end. However, they are a necessary means to the end. Thus, to say Christianity is not about propositions but about relationships is to establish an extremely dangerous false dichotomy. It is to insult the Spirit of truth, whose propositions they are. These propositions should be our very meat and drink, for they define the Christian life.

Christian teacher loses job after refusing to deceive parents on kids' gender transitions: 'From the devil'

A California teacher, who lost her job after refusing to comply with a California district's gender policies, citing Christian beliefs, is blowing the whistle on the expectations she felt as a teacher to not only hide students' gender transitions from parents, but also to keep them in the dark through lying.

"I knew immediately, like in my gut, in my heart, in my soul, that there was a decision I had to make because, you know, these two things were totally butting heads," Jessica Tapia, who worked at the Jurupa Unified School District, told Fox News Digital. "I essentially had to pick one. Am I going to obey the district in the directive that are not lining up with... my own beliefs, convictions and faith? Or am I going to stay true..., choose my faith, choose to be obedient to... the way the Lord has called me to live. And so it was crazy to be in the position where I realized that I couldn't be a Christian and a teacher."


